**Introduction**

Cemex is the leading global building solution provider and cement supplier. Following a successful project by Interiors for Cemex in Rugby, the company was appointed via a competitive tender to refurbish its Thorpe head office to create a new sustainable working environment.

**Details**

Interiors delivered the head office refurbishment in 11 carefully planned phases, with Cemex staff decanted in sequence to ensure minimal disruption while their offices were modernised.

The scope was technically challenging and included restructuring an existing swimming pool to create an enlarged office space. Most of the existing office space was also redeveloped to create an open plan environment with new IT infrastructure.

Work also included refurbishing a Grade II listed Georgian Manor House to create executive accommodation.

**Successes**

Refurbishing 75,000 square feet of office space and new executive accommodation to transform Cemex's head office.

The use of natural daylight and ventilation also provides a pleasant, bright working environment for staff and impressive place for visitors.

Sustainable technology has reduced energy consumption and therefore operating costs.
