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**Description**

Working with the City of London Corporation, Willmott Dixon Interiors are currently delivering Phase 3 of the ABP Facility refurbishment in the Smithfield Market.

During the three phases the existing market building will be fitted with an administration office and a maintenance workshop.

Phase 1 included demolition and strip out works to the existing facility, following which a new maintenance workshop was built. The existing maintenance workshop was then relocated to the new area and the space was prepared for Phase 3 - the construction of the Animal By Product facility. Phase 2 was carried out simultaneously to Phase 3 and involved a complete fit out of the administration office.

Phase 3 works include an installation of a panelling to create a fully sealed hygienic unit, which has negative air pressure and installation of air filtration system to prevent potential hazards.
